# To a Fallen Soldier

On July 9, 1880, a soldier was laid to rest at the Stockton Rural Cemetery and he was not given a headstone to mark his passing. His name was Jonathan Green Hatch and had served in the 123<sup>rd</sup> NY Infantry of Union Army from 1862 until 1865 – the period of the American Civil War.

On Saturday, April 11, 2015 at 10:00 am, 135 years after his passing, a dedication ceremony will be held in his honor and he will finally have a headstone.

Members of the Sons Of Union Veterans of the Civil War and Sons of Veterans Reserve will muster in full 1860's Union Army uniform at the Stockton Rural Cemetery to Honor this veteran with the dedication of a headstone.

Finally this soldier will be honored and shown the respect that should be afforded to all United States Service Men & Women.
